Meharban and Lisa were invited to seminars in Denmark by Oticon and Switzerland by Phonak.

Below are a few photo's and some info of how we got on.

In March we were taken to Oticon's research and development centre in Denmark and we were introduced to Agil.

This intelligent hearing solution is based on the most advanced technical principles, and has been created with one thing in mind: To make it easier for you to focus on what you want to hear by supporting your own natural ability to organize sounds.

Oticon Agil introduces new features designed to make you feel confident about playing an active role in conversations, even in difficult listening situations:

- Speech Guard: Helps you select and follow voices, and actively participate in conversations.

Phonak took us to the beautiful swiss alps and it was here where we were introduced to Lyric CIC.

Aptly named 'The contact lens for your ear', tThis breakthrough hearing aid from Phonak requires no handling at all and remains in your ear 24/7. And the best thing is: no one can see how well you hear!

Lyric is worn 24 hours a day, seven days a week, for months at a time. You can wear Lyric during your daily activities - suchas showering, talking on the phone, exercising, using headphones and even at night while sleeping. It is completely invisible from the outside and allows you to enjoy your hearing again.

New regulator for the hearing aid Industry...

Assuring high quality Professional Hearing Care by protecting the public.

The Hearing Aid Industry has gone through considerable changes. Firstly, with the abolition of the Hearing Aid Council (HAC) on 31 July 2010. HAC was the regulator of independent hearing aid sector for 40 years.

Secondly, on 1 April 2010 the responsibility for regulating Hearing Aid Dispensers was transferred to the Health Professions Council (HPC).

What is the HPC? They regulate health professionals in the UK and were set up to protect the public. They only register professionals who meet their standards for training, professional skills and behaviour. They can take action against health professionals who fall below these standards and can also prosecute those who pretend to be registered.

Health professionals must be registered so you can be sure:

- That the dispenser you are dealing with is genuine;
- They meet national standards; and
- You are protected.

You can check with the HPC if a health professional is registered.

British Society of Hearing Aid Audiologists (BSHAA) Assured Hearing Care and Customer Care Scheme.

As full member of The BSHAA we are pleased to announce that we have signed up to the BSHAA Assured Hearing Care and Customer Care Scheme recently introduced. This scheme is designed to give extra reassurance to clients in that the member(s) adhere to consumer policies of fair trading and agrees to a strict procedure in the event of anyone being dissatisfied with their purchase. When dealing with hearing aid dispensers it is important that you enquire if the dispenser is a member of BSHAA and if they offer the customer care scheme, as there are many dispensers who do not.


